CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

POWDER VALLEY WATER CONTROL DISTRICT P.O. BOX 189 NORTH POWDER, OREGON 97867

confirms the right to use the waters of ANTHONY CREEK, a tributary of the NORTH POWDER RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 144.0 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UNION County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 3, at Page The date of priority is 1898.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 3.5 cubic feet per second from March 1st to July 1st and 1.80 cubic feet per second from July 1st to October 1st of each year; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 360 acre feet (IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION DESCRIBED BELOW) .

The points of diversion are located as follows:

CARNES DITCH (ORIGINAL DIVERSION POINT) - SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, W.M.; 1400 FEET SOUTH AND 3800 FEET WEST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 19; AND

LONE PINE DITCH (ADDITIONAL DIVERSION POINT) NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 17, TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 39 EAST, W.M., 2400 FEET NORTH AND 100 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 17.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

> NE 1/4 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 40.0 ACRES 35.0 ACRES SW 1/4 SW 1/4 35.0 ACRES

> SE 1/4 SW 1/4 34.0 ACRES

TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, W.M.

The diversion works shall include a headgate, an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water and the type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of the watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 29, 1989, and supersedes Certificate 1531, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
