CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

R.A. WILKERSON
LAGRANDE OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of the GRANDE RONDE RIVER, a tributary of SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 23.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 10822. The date of priority is MARCH 20, 1933. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.294 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 33, T 2 S, R 38 E, W.M..

The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 20.0 ACRES
SECTION 33

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 1.00 ACRE
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 2.70 ACRES
SECTION 32

TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to correct a scrivener's error contained in the certificate recorded at page 79509, State Record of Water Right Certificates. Certificate 79509 incorrectly identified the range character in the description of the point of diversion. This certificate supersedes Certificate 79509.

Certificate 79509 describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 10141, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director approving Transfer Application 8411.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
