CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of BIG BUTTER CREEK, a tributary of the UMATILLA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 222.6 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UMATILLA County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 3, at Page 250. The date of priority is 1880 FOR 0.5 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) AND 1890 FOR 3.85 CFS.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 4.35 CFS or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 30, T 1 N, R 28 E, W.M.; MORRIS DITCH - 730 FEET SOUTH AND 590 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER, SECTION 30.


This certificate is issued in accordance with OAR 690-015-0090 to confirm the water right for a non-completed change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 15, 1987, at Special Order Volume 41, Page 276, approving Transfer 5911, and supercedes Certificate 2651, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
