## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RICK L. HALE P.O. BOX 110 HERMISTON, OREGON 97838

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 2 in the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 237.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-7183. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 25, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 2.97 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW¼ SE¼, SECTION 24, T 4 N, R 28 E, W.M.; 1230 FEET NORTH AND 1910 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 24.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

This certificate is issued in accordance with OAR 690-015-0090 to confirm the water right for a non-completed change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 14, 1997, at Special Order Volume 51, Page 653, approving Transfer 7753, and together with Certificate 79889, supercedes Certificate 53255, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
