CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BENJAMIN J. NEWMAN
c/o MARY C. NEWMAN
311 W. HIGHLAND
HERMISTON, OREGON 97838

confirms the right to use the waters of the BEN NEWMAN WELL, within the UMATILLA RIVER basin, for IRRIGATION OF 16.2 ACRES and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 11.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-6785. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 29, 1972. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.35 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well.

The point of appropriation is located as follows:

TWP	RNG	SEC	QTR-QTR	LOCATION
4	N 28 E	20	NE SW	W.M. 20 FEET SOUTH AND 2380 FEET EAST FROM THE W¼ CORNER OF SECTION 20

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:



The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 54736, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director approving Transfer 9311, entered FEB 18 2003, and recorded at Special Order Volume 57, Page 84. This certificate also confirms the diminution of 11.7 acres from primary to supplemental irrigation as authorized by the order approving Transfer 9311.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
