## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BLUE MOUNTAIN DITCH COMPANY C/O HOMER HARRISON ROUTE 1, BOX 130 MT. VERNON, OREGON 97865



confirms the right to use the waters of the JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 434.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 3163. The date of priority is OCTOBER 23, 1916. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 5.43 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SW¼ SW¼, SE½ SW¼, SECTION 21; NE½ NW¼, SECTION 26, T 13 S, R 29 E, W.M.; BOYCE DITCH - SOUTH 27 DEGREES 30 MINUTES EAST 1817 FEET FROM THE W¼ CORNER OF SECTION 21; 680 FEET NORTH AND 780 FEET WEST FROM THE S¼ CORNER OF SECTION 21; 740 FEET SOUTH AND 3480 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 26; SW¼ NE¾, SECTION 29, T 13 S, R 30 E, W.M.; BLUE MOUNTAIN DITCH - 565 FEET NORTH AND 2320 FEET WEST FROM THE E¼ CORNER OF SECTION 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1.0 acre-foot per acre for each acre irrigated during any month prior to July 1, and thereafter 3/4 of one acre-foot per acre for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1 to September 30 of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
