CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That W. W. Rawson

of Rt. 1, The Dalles, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Three Mile Crook

for the purpose of Stock and Domestic Water

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 10, at page 46; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from that said right is by virtue of ownership of land riparian to said stream;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for said purposes and not to exceed 0.10 of one-cubic-foot per second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

27 rods south, and 120 rods west of the NE corner of Section 22, but a part also being in S 1/2 of SE 1/4, Section 15, to the north.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
