CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

THE SUCCESSORS TO  
 OREGON LAND AND WATER COMPANY  
 IRRIGON, OREGON 97844

confirms the right to use the waters of the UMATILLA RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 46.25 ACRES, DOMESTIC USE AND STOCK WATER.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UMATILLA COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 3, at Pages 213-215. The date of priority is APRIL 14, 1893.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.58 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, subject to the provisions of Paragraph 33 of the decree, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on November 22, 2004, and recorded in Special Order Volume 61, Page 555, approving a petition by West Extension Irrigation District under ORS 541.329.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
