CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

L & L FARMS
P.O. BOX 63
ECHO, OR 97826

confirms the right to use the waters of WELLS NO. 1 AND 2 in the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 11.5 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 104.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-6574. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 17, 1975. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.15 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

WELL NO. 1 - SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 12, TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 28 EAST, W.M.; 1280 FEET NORTH AND 1250 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 12; AND

WELL NO. 2 - NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 12, TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 28 EAST, W.M.; 135 FEET NORTH AND 1820 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 12.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SECTION 12
TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 28 EAST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

When required by the Department the water user shall install and in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 26, 1993, and supersedes Certificate 52902, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
