 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROBERT G. AND GEORGE W. SICARD  
 BOARDMAN, OREGON 97818

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 31.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-1528. The date of priority is DECEMBER 29, 1959. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.4 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The well is located as follows:

4	N	25	E	W.M.	14	SW NW 3810 FEET NORTH AND 525 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 14

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate confirms an order of the Director entered on November 22, 2004, and recorded in Special Order Volume 61 Page 555, approving a petition by West Extension Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate, together with Certificate 79935, supersedes Certificate 30194 of the State Record of Water Right Certificates.


This is an order other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said permit.
