CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the HAT ROCK DRAIN (COLUMBIA RIVER) for IRRIGATION OF 28.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-6041. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 20, 1974. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.35 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 29, T 5 N, R 29 E, W.M.; 320 FEET SOUTH AND 1770 FEET EAST FROM THE W $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE¼ SW¼ 13.7 ACRES
NW¼ SW¼ 14.4 ACRES

SECTION 29
TOWNSHIP 5 NORTH, RANGE 29 EAST, W.M.


The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to correct a scrivener's error contained in the certificate recorded at page 79693, State Record of Water Right Certificates. Certificate 79693 incorrectly described the permit number as G-6401. The correct permit number is G-6041. This certificate supersedes Certificate 79693.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 53387, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAR 17 2003, approving Transfer Application 8910.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
