CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of HORSESHOE LAKE, a tributary of the WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 29.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 34633. The date of priority is AUGUST 29, 1969. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.37 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, AS PROJECTED WITHIN J. MOORE DLC 59, SECTION 22, T 11 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 2050 FEET SOUTH AND 1480 FEET WEST FROM THE NW CORNER OF W. MOORE DLC 60.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 2.2 ACRES
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 2.2 ACRES
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 11.9 ACRES
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 13.6 ACRES
ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN J. MOORE DLC 59
SECTION 22
TOWNSHIP 11 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 42198, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAR 17 2003, approving Transfer Application 9111.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
