CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 1.42 ACRES; AND DOMESTIC USE EXPANDED FOR ONE HOUSEHOLD, FURTHER RESTRICTED TO HUMAN CONSUMPTION INCLUDING DOMESTIC ANIMAL CONSUMPTION THAT IS ANCILLARY TO RESIDENTIAL USE OF THE PROPERTY AND IRRIGATION OF ONE-HALF ACRE NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN.

This right was perfected under Permit 54020. The date of priority is AUGUST 11, 1992. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.03 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.02 CFS FOR IRRIGATION DURING THE PERIODS OF MARCH 1 THROUGH AUGUST 31 AND OCTOBER 1 THROUGH OCTOBER 31 OF EACH YEAR; AND 0.01 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE EXPANDED DURING THE PERIOD OF OCTOBER 1 THROUGH AUGUST 31 OF EACH YEAR, FURTHER RESTRICTED TO 0.01 CFS FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION INCLUDING DOMESTIC ANIMAL CONSUMPTION THAT IS ANCILLARY TO RESIDENTIAL USE OF THE PROPERTY AND IRRIGATION OF ONE-HALF ACRE NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN DURING THE PERIOD OF SEPTEMBER 1 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30 OF EACH YEAR, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 8, (SE 1/4 NE 1/4), SECTION 17, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.; 980 FEET NORTH AND 40 FEET WEST FROM THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 17.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 5 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4) 1.23 ACRES AND DOMESTIC
SECTION 16
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

The Director finds the use of water described by this right, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.
