CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SCOTT E. WOODRUFF

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 1.0 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 19661. The date of priority is MAY 10, 1950. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.012 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN CALVIN REED DLC 47, SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.; 130 FEET NORTH AND 320 FEET EAST FROM THE WEST 1/16 CORNER COMMON TO SECTIONS 19 AND 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, subject to the terms and conditions of that agreement between Elton V. Jackson and California Oregon Power Company dated September 1, 1950.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 1.0 ACRE
AS PROJECTED WITHIN CALVIN REED DLC 47
SECTION 19
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The water user shall install and maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device. The type and plans of the screen or by-pass device must be approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife and shall be installed under the supervision of the Department of Fish and Wildlife.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 21, 2001, and supersedes a portion of Certificate 76315, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
