CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

R.A. LINDSAY
WILDERVILLE, OREGON 97543

confirms the right to use the waters of CHANEY CREEK, a tributary of the APPLGATE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 10.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is JULY 5, 1884.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.17 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 18, T 37 S, R 6 W, W.M.; LINDSAY DITCH.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 10.0 ACRES
SECTION 18
TOWNSHIP 37 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 57582, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAR 26 2003, approving Transfer Application 8227.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
