## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of CHANEY CREEK, a tributary of the APPLEGATE RIVER, to maintain instream flows for FISHERIES ENHANCEMENT.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is JULY 5, 1884.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.073 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source, during the period FROM APRIL 1 TO OCTOBER 31 of each year.

The authorized point of diversion is located as follows:

NW¼ SW¼, SECTION 18, T 37 S, R 6 W, W.M.; LINDSAY DITCH DIVERSION.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

From the authorized point of diversion in the NW½ SW½, SECTION 18, T 37 S, R 6 W, W.M.; LINDSAY DITCH DIVERSION, to the confluence with the Applegate River in the SW½ SE½, SECTION 6, T 37 S, R 6 W, W.M..

This instream right shall replace a portion of the existing instream rights for CHENEY CREEK, evidenced by CERTIFICATE 73038, during the irrigation season each year, FROM APRIL 1 TO OCTOBER 31 OF EACH YEAR.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use and place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director approving Transfer 8227, and supersedes Certificate 57582, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use in the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
