CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of POWDER RIVER, a tributary of the SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 17.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 40493. The date of priority is MARCH 31, 1976. The right is limited to not more than 0.39 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or the equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or the equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the right confirmed by Certificate 64799, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered ________, and recorded at Special Order Volume 57, Page 245, canceling a portion of the right. This certificate supersedes Certificate 64799.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective priority date prior to this right.
