## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

THOMAS FITZGERALD MITCHELL, OREGON 97750

confirms the right to use the waters of BEAR CREEK, a tributary of BRIDGE CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 42.3 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for WHEELER County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 12, at Page 388. The dates of priority are 1892 FOR TRACT 1 AND PRIOR TO 1889 FOR TRACT 2.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.06 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND BEFORE JUNE 15 AND 0.53 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND AFTER JUNE 15, DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON FROM MARCH 1 TO OCTOBER 1 OF EACH YEAR, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

TRACT 1 - PIERSON DITCH

TRACT 2 - MAIN DITCH.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre to June 15 and ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre after June 15, during the irrigation season from March 1 to October 1, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.
