confirms the right to use the waters of WALKER-VAN OTTEN RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-1405, a tributary of SALT CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 28.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 50853. The date of priority is DECEMBER 13, 1989. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 28.0 ACRE-FEET OF STORED WATER ONLY, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

WALKER-VAN OTTEN RESERVOIR DAM - LOT 3 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4), SECTION 14, TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.; AND

RE-DIVERSION - LOT 3 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4), SECTION 14, TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.; 1800 FEET NORTH AND 170 FEET EAST FROM THE SE CORNER OF J. EADES DLC NO 47.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 ½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 2 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4) 3/1 ACRES LOT 3 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4) 15.7 ACRES LOT 4 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4) 7.2 ACRES LOT 1 (SE 1/4 NE 1/4) 2.0 ACRES SECTION 14 TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
