CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WESTPORT WATER ASSOCIATION

confirms the right to use the waters of WEST CREEK, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for QUASI-MUNICIPAL USE.

This right was perfected under Permit 30688. The date of priority is JULY 29, 1965. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.50 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

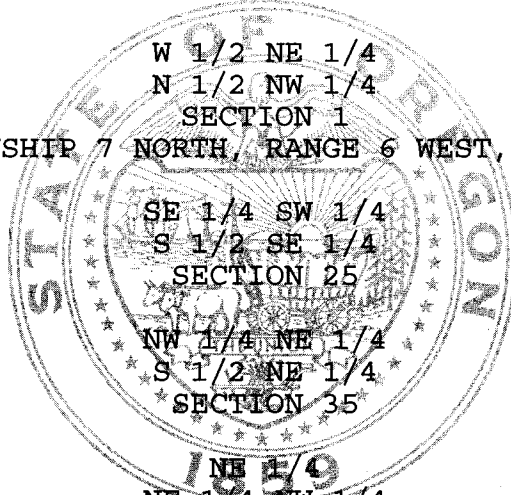
The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 1, TOWNSHIP 7 NORTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.; 332.17 FEET NORTH AND 2200.85 FEET WEST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 1.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

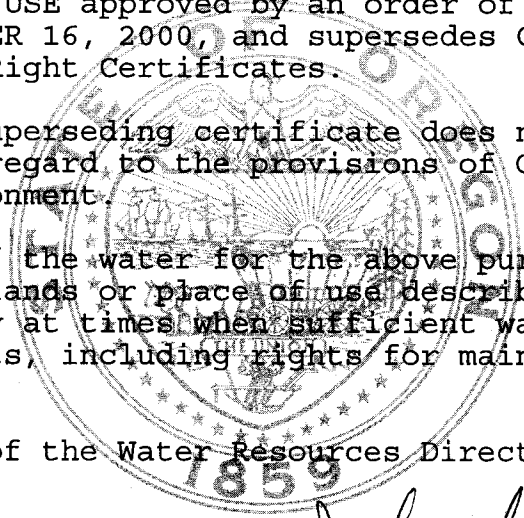
Water may be applied to lands which are not specifically described above, provided the holder of this right complies with ORS 540.510(3).

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND A CHANGE IN CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 16, 2000, and supersedes Certificate 39031, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
