confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING, a tributary of TURNER CREEK, for DOMESTIC USE FOR TWO HOUSES.

This right was perfected under Permit 40244. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 25, 1976. This right is limited to 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.; 100 FEET SOUTH AND 70 FEET WEST FROM THE CENTER 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 10.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 SECTION 10 TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights including rights for maintaining instream flows.
