CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A SMALL MARSHY SPRING, a tributary of LITTLE PINE CREEK, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE LAWN AND NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN.

This right was perfected under Permit 49705. The date of priority is MAY 22, 1986. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 6, TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 32 EAST, W.M.; 45 FEET SOUTH AND 165 FEET WEST FROM THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 4 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4)
SECTION 5
TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 32 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
