CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CITY OF COOS BAY
500 CENTRAL AVENUE
COOS BAY, OREGON 97420

confirms the right to use the waters of LOWER EMPIRE LAKE, a tributary of CHICKSES CREEK, for MUNICIPAL USE.

This right was perfected under Permit 29011. The date of priority is JUNE 29, 1960, FOR 159.99 ACRE-FEET (AF) AND SEPTEMBER 23, 1963, FOR 32.41 AF. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 192.4 AF STORED WATER ONLY, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 17, TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 13 WEST, W.M.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4
SECTION 16

S 1/2 SE 1/4
SECTION 17

N 1/2 NE 1/4
SECTION 20

TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 13 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.
