CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DOUGLAS COUNTY WATER RESOURCES SURVEY

ROSEBURG, OREGON 97470

confirms the right to store the waters of BERRY CREEK, a tributary of OLALLA CREEK, in BEN IRVING RESERVOIR, appropriated under Permit No.'s 43056 AND 43057, for MUNICIPAL, QUASI-MUNICIPAL AND STREAM FLOW AUGMENTATION.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-7256. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 15, 1977. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is not more than 2250.0 acre-feet.

The dam shall be operated and maintained according to the approved plans and specifications on file with the Water Resources Department.
