CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

IDAHO POWER COMPANY
PO BOX 70
BOISE, IDAHO 83707

confirms the right to use the waters of SNAKE RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 8.66 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-50644. The date of priority is DECEMBER 9, 1988. This right is limited to 0.22 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 5 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4), SECTION 9, TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 48 EAST, W.M.;
1117 FEET SOUTH AND 1179 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 9.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 3 (SE 1/4 NW 1/4) 0.75 ACRES
LOT 4 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4) 6.96 ACRES
LOT 5 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4) 0.95 ACRES
SECTION 9
TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 48 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.
