CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CITY OF SALEM
555 LIBERTY STREET SE
SALEM, OREGON 97301

confirms the right to use the waters of the WILLAMETTE RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 6.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 32148. The date of priority is JUNE 16, 1967. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 6 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4), SECTION 28, TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.; 1670 FEET NORTH AND 260 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SMITH DLC 76.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 2 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4)	0.90 ACRES
LOT 6 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4)	0.20 ACRES
SE 1/4 NW 1/4	5.50 ACRES
SECTION 33	
TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.	

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.
