confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING, tributary of LAWRENCE CREEK, for LIVESTOCK.

This right was perfected under Permit 51036. The date of priority is July 18, 1988. This right is limited to 500 GALLONS PER DAY, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 9 WEST, W.M.; 915.35 FEET NORTH AND 491.96 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 33.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 32
TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 9 WEST, W.M.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use without waste on the lands or place of use described. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.
