CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

W.J. TOWNLEY
UNION, OREGON 97783

confirms the right to use the waters of LADD CREEK, CATHERINE CREEK, and HOT LAKE SPRING, tributaries of the GRAND RONDE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 1791.5 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UNION County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 8, at Page 1. The date of priority is see "place of use" below.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed three acre-feet per acre in any irrigation season or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

LADD CREEK: SE¼ SE¼ SECTION 36, T 3 S, R 38 E, W.M.;
CATHERINE CREEK: SW¼ NW¼ SECTION 3, T 4 S, R 39 E, W.M.; AND
HOT LAKE SPRING.
