confirms the right to use the waters of WELLS NO.'S 1 AND 2 in the MARKS CREEK BASIN for SCHOOL USE.

This right was perfected under Permit G-11041. The date of priority is APRIL 6, 1989. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 9600 GALLONS PER DAY, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

WELL NO. 1 - SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 3, TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 19 EAST, W.M.; 57 FEET SOUTH AND 165 FEET EAST OF THE CS 1/16TH CORNER, SECTION 3; AND

WELL NO. 2 - SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 3, TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 19 EAST, W.M.; 772 FEET SOUTH AND 353 FEET EAST OF THE CS 1/16TH CORNER, SECTION 3.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW/1/4 SE 1/4 SECTION 3

TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 19 EAST, W.M.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

The Department may require water level or pump test results every ten years.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use without waste on the lands or place of use described. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
