CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROBERT A. DUDLEY  
ROUTE 2, BOX 1390  
ROSEBURG, OREGON 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of the NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 40.72 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 26192. The date of priority is MAY 15, 1959. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.513 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE¼ SE¼, SECTION 22, T 26 S, R 6 W, W.M..

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of water in the North Umpqua River is 525 c.f.s. or more at its mouth.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW¼ SE¼ 26.95 ACRES  
AS PROJECTED WITHIN EVANS DLC 43  
SE¼ SE¼ 9.49 ACRES  
AS PROJECTED WITHIN EVANS DLC 43  
SE¼ SE¼ 4.28 ACRES  
SECTION 22  
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.


The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 29960, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 28 2003, approving Transfer Application 9102.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
