CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO
U.S. WINEMA NATIONAL FOREST
2819 DAHLIA STREET
KLAMATH FALLS, OREGON 97601

confirms the right to use the waters of BEDPAN SPRING, a tributary of the KLAMATH MARSH for LIVESTOCK.

This right was perfected under Permit 51001. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 23, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, NOT TO EXCEED 3,000 GALLONS PER DAY, or its equivalent in case of rotation measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.;
2300 FEET SOUTH AND 1250 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 32.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4
SECTION 32
TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
