CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GLENN CHOWNING  
1645 ORCHARD AVENUE  
HERMISTON, OR 97838

confirms the right to use the waters of the COLUMBIA RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION OF 12.0 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 40.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 45563. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 5, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.50 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 7 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), SECTION 2, T 4 N, R 25 E, WM; 150 FEET SOUTH AND 2990 FEET WEST FROM THE NORTHEAST CORNER, SECTION 2.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that although declared herein to be for supplemental irrigation in part the right allowed may, in the interest of conserving the ground water supplies, be exercised at times when water is available in the ground water supply provided that the total quantity diverted from all sources of supply does not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SECTION 10  
TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 26 EAST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.


When required by the Department, the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

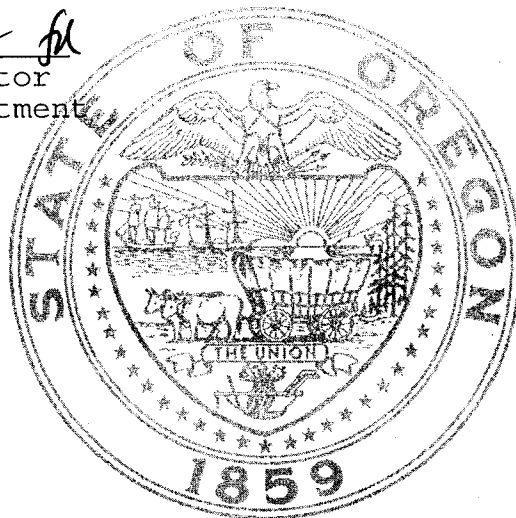
This certificate is issued to confirm a change in CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 20, 1998, and together with Certificate 75766, supersedes Certificate 52396, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
