CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GLENN CHOWNING 1645 ORCHARD AVENUE HERMISTON, OR 97838

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the COLUMBIA RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 5.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-1070. The date of priority is AUGUST 27, 1958. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.06 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW¼ NE¼, SECTION 10, T 3 N, R 26 E, WM; 1350 FEET SOUTH AND 1430 FEET WEST FROM THE NORTHEAST CORNER, SECTION 10.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH PANGE 26 EAST, W.M.

TE 2 AGRAS

When required by the Department, the water user shall install an inline flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.
