CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of UNNAMED SPRING CREEK (AKA CEDAR CREEK), a tributary of FIVE RIVERS, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY.

This right was perfected under Permit 42748. The date of priority is DECEMBER 19, 1977. This right is limited to 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 9 WEST, W.M., MOVABLE DIVERSION POINT BETWEEN, UPPER LIMIT - 70 FEET SOUTH AND 360 FEET WEST AND LOWER LIMIT - 740 FEET SOUTH AND 1160 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM NORTHEAST CORNER, SECTION 16.


The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4  
SECTION 16  
TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 9 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
