CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DICK R. AND JOYCE F. KOBAYASHI  
5591 BINNS HILL ROAD  
HOOD RIVER, OREGON 97031

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO UNNAMED SPRINGS, a tributaries of INDIAN CREEK, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY AND IRRIGATION OF 4.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 44720. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 13, 1979. This right is limited to 0.065 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE AND 0.06 CFS FOR IRRIGATION FROM SPRING #1, WITH ANY DEFICIENCY IN THE AVAILABLE SUPPLY FROM SPRING #1 TO BE MADE UP BY DIVERSION FROM SPRING #2 or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SPRING #1: NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 18, TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.; 1720 FEET NORTH AND 1250 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 18; AND

SPRING #2: NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 18, TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.; 1740 FEET NORTH AND 1280 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 18.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

DOMESTIC AND IRRIGATION OF 4.6 ACRES  
NW 1/4 SW 1/4  
SECTION 17  
TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
