CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JACK D. CORNWELL  
304 NE 83RD STREET  
VANCOUVER, WA 98665

confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING, a tributary of  
WALLOWA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 0.5 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 46664. The date of priority is  
DECEMBER 18, 1981. This right is limited to 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER  
SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of  
diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 28, TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 45 EAST,  
W.M.; 220 FEET SOUTH AND 120 FEET EAST FROM THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF  
THE SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount  
secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited  
to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its  
equivalent) and 3.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the  
irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be  
ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant  
is as follows:


SW 1/4 NW 1/4 0.5 ACRE  
SECTION 28  
TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 45 EAST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is  
subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for  
judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the  
date of service.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
