CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MALCOLM J. AND ELEANOR S. MONTAGUE

confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING AND AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of SALMON RIVER, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR THREE FAMILIES FROM A SPRING AND IRRIGATION OF 0.1 ACRE FROM UNNAMED STREAM.

This right has been perfected under Permit 47257. The date of priority is JULY 1, 1982. This right is limited to 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.005 CFS FROM EACH SOURCE or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SPRING: LOT 4 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4), SECTION 23, TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 11 WEST, W.M.; 195 FEET SOUTH AND 20 FEET EAST FROM THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 23; AND

STREAM: LOT 5 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4), SECTION 23, TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 11 WEST, W.M.; 190 FEET SOUTH AND 220 FEET WEST FROM THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 23.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2 1/2 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.


This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

LOT 5 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4) DOMESTIC AND 0.1 ACRE
SECTION 23
TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 11 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
