CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ALSEA, OREGON 97324-9622

confirms the right to use the waters of ALSEA RIVER, a tributary of PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATING 0.3 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 48516. The date of priority is MAY 10, 1984. This right is limited to 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 24, TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 9 WEST, W.M.;
950 FEET SOUTH AND 580 FEET EAST FROM THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 24.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

0.3 ACRE NW 1/4 NE 1/4
SECTION 24
TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 9 WEST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.
