CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM G. PITMAN

HILLSBORO, OREGON 97124

confirms the right to use the waters of UNNAMED CREEK, a tributary of SCOGGINS CREEK, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN.

This right was perfected under Permit 49177. The date of priority is DECEMBER 11, 1984. This right is limited to 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

Provided further, water shall not be appropriated during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year except for human consumption.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 12, TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.;
390 FEET NORTH AND 1190 FEET EAST FROM WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 12.


The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4
SECTION 12
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
