CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DONALD K. AND EILEEN M. BISSON
23849 WOODS CREEK ROAD
PHILOMATH, OREGON 97370

confirms the right to use the waters of WOODS CREEK, a tributary of MARYS RIVER, for IRRIGATING 0.4 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 49684. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 4, 1985. This right is limited to 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4 AS PROJECTED WITHIN HENKLE DLC 74, SECTION 4, TOWNSHIP 12 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.; 530 FEET SOUTH AND 160 FEET WEST FROM THE EASTERLY NORTHEAST CORNER OF HENKLE DLC 74.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4 0.4 ACRE
AS PROJECTED WITHIN HENKLE DLC 74
SECTION 4
TOWNSHIP 12 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
