confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING, a tributary of EAST BEAVER CREEK, for DOMESTIC FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN.

This right was perfected under Permit 49691. The date of priority is MARCH 27, 1986. This right is limited to 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 SECTION 21, TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 9 WEST, W.M.; 1300 FEET SOUTH AND 460 FEET EAST FROM THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 21.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4
SECTION 21
TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 9 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
