CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BARBARA A. LYONS

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO STREAMS, tributaries of ISTHMUS SLOUGH, for DOMESTIC USE FOR AND IRRIGATION OF 1.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 50008. The date of priority is MARCH 23, 1987. This right is limited to 0.0325 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.01 CFS FROM DIVERSION 1 (STREAM 3) FOR DOMESTIC USE FOR TWO FAMILIES AND 0.0225 CFS FROM DIVERSION 2 (STREAM 4) FOR IRRIGATION or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

DIVERSION 1: LOT 3 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4) SECTION 24, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 13 WEST, W.M.; 1500 FEET NORTH AND 600 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 24; AND

DIVERSION 2: LOT 12 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4) SECTION 23, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 13 WEST, W.M.; 1220 FEET WEST FROM THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 24.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

STREAM 3 STREAM 4
DOMESTIC 1.8 ACRES
NW 1/4 SE 1/4
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 37
SECTION 23
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 13 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
