CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RAY C. GARDNER
68 VILLAGE LANE
ONTARIO, OREGON 97914

confirms the right to use the waters of DOUGLAS CREEK, a tributary of the SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 0.5 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 48966. The date of priority is OCTOBER 12, 1984. This right is limited to 0.012 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 12, TOWNSHIP 12 SOUTH, RANGE 45 EAST, W.M.; 860 FEET NORTH AND 200 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 12.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and FOUR acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.


The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.5 ACRE
SECTION 12
TOWNSHIP 12 SOUTH, RANGE 45 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
