CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of CLEAR CREEK, a tributary of PINE CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 25.0 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for BAKER County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 11, at Page 235. The date of priority is 1870.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed ONE-FORTIETH of a cubic foot per second per acre, measured at the point of diversion, and a total limitation of ONE ACRE-FOOT PER ACRE DURING JULY, ONE ACRE-FOOT PER ACRE DURING AUGUST, AND ONE-HALF ACRE-FOOT PER ACRE DURING SEPTEMBER, of each year.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 9, T 8 S, R 46 E, W.M.; 2500 FEET NORTH AND 1430 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 9.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 12.5 ACRES
SECTION 15



TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 46 EAST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a historic change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUL 24 2003, approving Transfer Application 8932, and supercedes Certificate 10362, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
