## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of YALE CREEK, a tributary of LITTLE APPLEGATE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 60.64 ACRES AND DEVELOPMENT OF 4 HORSEPOWER.

This right was perfected under Permit 43583. The date of priority is 1865 FOR 0.74 CFS FOR IRRIGATION OF 29.6 ACRES; 1880 FOR 0.63 CFS FOR IRRIGATION OF 25 ACRES; 1907 FOR 0.16 CFS FOR IRRIGATION OF 6.5 ACRES; AND DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE; AND 1907 FOR 0.15 CFS FOR FARM POWER WHEEL. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.66 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversions are located as follows:

GARRISON DITCH: NW% NE%, SECTION 32, T 39 S, R 2 W, W.M.; AND RILEY-PHILLIPS DITCH: SW% NE%, SECTION 32, T 39 S, R 2 W, W.M..

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This certificate corrects a scrivener's error in the certificate recorded at page 43583, State Record of Water Right Certificates. Certificate 43583 incorrectly described the point of diversion for the portion of the water right not modified by the order approving Transfer 3225. This certificate contains the corrected point of diversions, and supersedes Certificate 43583.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 43583, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_, approving Transfer Application 8765.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
