CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GLENN E. CHASTAIN
ROUTE 1, BOX 131
MAUPIN, OREGON 97037

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM AND RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-3212, a tributary of WHITE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 15.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 28619. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 11, 1963. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.38 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW¼ NW¼, SECTION 26, T 4 S, R 13 E, W.M.; 40 FEET SOUTH AND 750 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-3212; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the direct flow of White River is more than 95 cubic feet per second at its mouth.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW¼ SW¼ 15.1 ACRES
SECTION 23
TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST, W.M.


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 52413, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUL 24 2003, approving Transfer Application 7334.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
