confirms the right to use the waters of BRANCH OF JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 2.5 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for GRANT County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 15, at Page 461. The date of priority is 1868.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed ONE-FORTIETH CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) PER ACRE IRRIGATED TO JUNE 1 AND ONE-EIGHTIETH CFS PER ACRE THEREAFTER, FURTHER LIMITED TO ONE ACRE-FOOT PER CALENDAR MONTH TO JUNE 1 AND FOUR ACRE-FEET DURING SEASON APRIL 1 TO SEPTEMBER 30, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

RICE DITCH - SE% NW%, SECTION 22, T 13 S, R 34 E, W.M.; 1400 FEET SOUTH AND 1900 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 22.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
