CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

H.G. HURLBURT
HERMISTON, OREGON 97838

confirms the right to use the waters of the UMATILLA RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 65.9 ACRES, SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 2.7 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 2554. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 3, at Page 127. The date of priority is 1910.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled and hereby confirmed is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.86 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, subject to the provisions of paragraph 33 of said decree and all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW



This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 2554, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of orders of the Water Resources Director entered August 7, 2003, approving Transfer Applications T-8320 and T-8322 and diminishing a portion of the right (T-8320).

The issuance of this certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610, pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
