CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

A.P. SNYDER  
DAYVILLE, OREGON 97825

confirms the right to use the waters of the JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 38.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 194. The date of priority is JANUARY 31, 1910. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.48 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , SECTION 1, T 13 S, R 26 E, W.M..

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 412, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 12 2003, approving Transfer Application 8832.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
