CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DAN R. KEWISH P.O. BOX 1080 ROGUE RIVER, OREGON 97537

confirms the right to use the waters of EVANS CREEK, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 16.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 19543. The date of priority is JUNE 5, 1950. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.20 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION DESCRIBED AS THE FIELDER AND HILLS DITCH - NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 7, TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.; 475 FEET SOUTH AND 120 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 7), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 12, TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.; 1185 FEET NORTH AND 30 FEET EAST FROM THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 12.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 ½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from April 2 to October 31 of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 4.4 ACRES NW 1/4 NW 1/4 1.3 ACRES SW 1/4 NW 1/4 4.1 ACRES SE 1/4 NW 1/4 6.2 ACRES

TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

When in the judgement of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

- 1) The diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled; and
- 2) The type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of the Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an orders of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 28, 1980 AND DECEMBER 19, 1997, and supersedes Certificate 23876, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
